
Hon. Bello Muhammed Goronyo Takes Swift Action, Summons Contractor Over N128 Million Irrigation Project

visit to the project site at Kiri, Shelleng Local Government Area. The undertaking, overseen by the Upper Benue River Basin Development Authority, Yola, had American West Africa Agro as the responsible company.
