Can he replicate his Lagos achievements for Nigeria as a whole?





Addressing Afenifere leaders at the residence of Pa Reuben Fasoranti in Akure, Ondo State, on Wednesday, 28<sup>th</sup> of February, 2024, the President emphasized his commitment to leading Nigeria towards economic and social prosperity.

Asiwaju said "Nigeria will survive the current economic challenges. There is light at the end of the tunnel. I requested the job, and I am not complaining about it. I take full responsibility. Recalled that during the electioneering, Asiwaju Bola Tinubu had been similarly quoted to have told Nigerians from different walks of life that he needs nobody's sympathy in whatever becomes of him as Nigeria President. He said "I campaigned for this office to serve Nigeria's interests, and I was elected. Some said I would not last in the tribunal and came up with all sorts of predictions, but even when in court, I remained focused.

"We cannot allow Nigeria's economy to be exploited. We cannot abandon our economy to marauders. I am determined to re-engineer our finances and curb selfish interests permanently," he stated.

The President told the leaders of the South West socio-political group that "we are meeting our obligations to the international community. To lenders, we have not defaulted, and we are not going to default. We are navigating the twists and bends on the road to Nigeria's prosperity," the President affirmed. The following day before heading to Qatar on invitation to a business summit, the president commissioned Lagos Red line rail, where he again assured the country that his administration is not contemplating backing down on what he believes is the right cause for the nation.

Asiwaju said "the Labour has gone on strike 4 times within my nine months in government. That's a record. However, they should join us to make Nigeria work as we are currently doing, otherwise if they want to be political, they should meet us in 2027." According to him, "democracy and governance are and must be for the people. As

Nigeria's annual inflation rate climbed further to a near 28-year high of 29.9% in January 2024, up from 28.9% in December and above market forecasts of 29.5%. Food inflation, which accounts for the bulk of Nigeria's inflation basket, quickened again to 35.4% in January from 33.9% a month earlier, with higher prices across a broad range of items including bread, fish, meat, fruit and eggs. On a monthly basis, consumer prices inched up by 2.6% in January, the most in five months, following a 2.3% rise in the previous month. source: National Bureau of Statistics, Nigeria

for our policy, it will continue. We will not stop it. Corruption must end in Nigeria. Yes, Corruption will fight back, we will fight it and ruin it. We will exterminate it! Nigeria money must be for the majority of Nigerians to build good education, healthcare and modern transportation for majority of the people. We are focused and determined and we are on track. In the end, all of us will be happy for all the sacrifices we made. The Hope is here, Nigeria will be out of economic problems."

Early in February, with the growing cost of food items in the country, the President after a meeting with Presidential Committee on Emergency Food Intervention directed the Ministry of Agriculture and Food Security to release about 42,000 metric tons of maize, millet, and other commodities in strategic reserves to address the rising cost of food in the country. This is apart from the assurances from the Rice Millers Association of Nigeria to release about 60,000 metric tons of rice to the markets.

This notwithstanding, Tinubu has also put forward an economic advisory committee, making the list were prominent members of the private sector, including the Chairman of United Bank for Africa,



Mr. Tony Elumelu, and the Chairman of Dangote Group, Aliko Dangote. At the maiden meeting with the advisory committee, Tinubu said the goal "is to provide additional"

efforts" in stabilising the economy and ensuring the "best economic future" for Nigerians.

According to Mr. President, he said "Let's look at what we're doing right and what we're doing wrong to bring life back to the economy. As I have said many times, the people of this country are only the people we have to please,"Not playing the role of Nostradamus, Asiwaju emphasized that "we are not saying that we have all the answers. But we will not be blamed for not trying. We assure Nigerians that we will do our best to get our marshall plan in place and fashion out the best economic future for this country."

Also attracting the attention of the government was the creation of Social Security Unemployment Programme by President Bola Ahmed, where unemployed youths will be paid to ease economic hardship. This initiative by President Bola Ahmed Tinubu is considered to have potential to significantly impact Nigeria's unemployed youth and the nation's economy. By providing a safety net for those struggling to find employment, the Social Security Unemployment Programme could help alleviate poverty and reduce income inequality.

The programme could also stimulate the economy, as the increased purchasing power of the beneficiaries may lead to higher consumer spending. Even though its success will depend on effective implementation, including


transparent eligibility criteria, efficient distribution of funds, and strict monitoring to ensure the benefits reach the intended recipients.

Speaking at the launch of the Expatriate Employment Levy handbook, the President also said the aim is to close wage gaps between expatriates and the Nigerian labour force, while increasing employment opportunities for qualified Nigerians in foreign companies operating in the country.

According to a statement issued by Chief Ajuri Ngelale, Special Adviser to the President on Media & Publicity, Tinubu, however, warned that the scheme should not be used as an impediment nor as a cudgel wielded to discourage foreign investors. "We expect improved revenue generation; improved naturalization and indigenization; we anticipate the employment of more qualified Nigerians by foreign companies operating in this country. We seek a greater balancing of

Nigerians. "I declare my support for the Expatriate Employment Levy scheme, and I will continue to encourage the operators, practitioners of immigration matters and expatriate quotas, but I emphasize: do not use it as a bottleneck; do not use it as an obstacle to frustrate potential investors.

Despite the frantic effort on the part of the nation's economic team, it appears that detractors are not resting, prompting the Office of the National security Adviser to sound a note of warning that it will confront the saboteurs headlong. For instance, on 20th of February, a statement by Zakari Mijinyawa, the head of Strategic Communication at the Office of the National Security Adviser says the measure is part of efforts to restore sanity to the nation's foreign exchange market and stabilise the economy. It further stated that in a concerted effort to safeguard Nigeria's foreign exchange market and combat speculative activities, the Office of the National Security Adviser (ONSA) and the Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN) are joining forces to address challenges impacting the nation's economic stability. Stressing further that The CBN's proactive measures to stabilise the foreign exchange market and stimulate economic activities have been commendable.

The statement noted that despite the move, its effectiveness is being undermined by the activities of speculators, both domestic and international, operating through various channels, thereby exacerbating the depreciation of the Nigerian Naira and contributing to inflation and economic instability.

Accordingly, the office of the National security Adviser added that intelligence reports have highlighted continued illicit activities within the Nigerian foreign exchange market, the ONSA and CBN are therefore embarking on this collaborative approach to tackle these infractions. This partnership will involve a coordinated effort with key law enforcement agencies, including the Nigeria Police

Force (NPF), the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC), the Nigeria Customs Service and the Nigeria Financial Intelligence Unit (NFIU).

The primary objective of this alliance is to systematically identify, thoroughly investigate and appropriately penalise individuals and organisations involved in wrongful activities within the Forex market,

Truth to this promise, news emerged on Thursday, 29th of February that two senior executives at Binance were reportedly detained in Nigeria, The executives flew to Nigeria following the country's decision to ban several cryptocurrency trading websites last week but they were detained by the office of the country's national security adviser and their passports seized. Already, apart from some unscrupulous bureau De change agents, fingers have been pointed in the direction of binance as one of the saboteurs who used the cyberspace to literarily hijack the role of the CBN on currency. The crackdown follows a period after several cryptocurrency websites emerged as platforms of choice for trading the Nigerian currency, which has suffered chronic dollar shortages.

Also among the effort at fastening the loose end of the economic policy of the government is a recapitalization done by the Central Bank of Nigeria penultimate week, in the news recapitalization, minimum capital requirements for BDC operators in Nigeria will be N2 billion for Tier 1 license holders. The bank added that the requirement for a Tier 2 license would be N500 million, marking a departure from the previous threshold of N35 million for a general license. Economic watchers believed this is a move in the right direction, yet it is not without element of challenge.

Although security is on the exclusive list of Nigeria's 1999 Constitution(as amended), yet it is everybody's responsibility in need of collective effort by the three tiers of government to ensure peace and serenity.

The provision of security to safeguard the lives and property of the citizens is thus one of the basic principles enshrined in the constitution of Federal Republic of Nigeria, so that they can live in peace and go about their day to day activities without threat to their wellbeing or any hindrance.

Therefore, the crux of the matter is that there will never be development

without security.


